# Lodging

During this lesson, the students will learn about lodging. Under this Terminal Learning Objective, the students will learn three tasks: find a place to stay, make a hotel reservation, and manage a household. At the end of the lesson, the students will be able to:

## Find a Place to Stay

- Extract information about housing from advertisements
- Discuss renting a house/apartment/room
- Rent an apartment for you and your family
- Specify what kind of accommodations you need
- Fill out and understand the terms of a rental agreement

## Make a Hotel Reservation

- Reserve a room in a hotel
- Register for a room in a hotel
- Give and seek information about the location of the nearest hotel
- Request a certain room size and amenities
- Ask for rates and hotel facilities
- Ask for room accommodations

#### Manage a Household

- Discuss the physical condition of the house
- Discuss utility costs
- Describe maintenance problems
- Talk about household chores
- Describe furniture
- Give a description of the appliances
- Compare living arrangements
- Interpret for non-speakers the use of cleaning services
  - Discuss types of rooms, furniture, and appliances

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## Tip of the Day

## **Renting a House or an Apartment**



Renting a house or an apartment in Korea is quite different than it is in America. 전세집 is the most common rental system in Korea and its English equivalent is "key money system." To rent a 전세집, you have to pay for the whole price of the house. You get your money back when you move out. There is no monthly payment at all. Recently, however, the number of modernized buildings has increased in metropolitan areas and the monthly rental system, common in western countries, is gaining popularity.

Korean 전세집 or apartments usually are COMPLETELY unfurnished, meaning that you must supply everything yourself, including light fixtures, blinds, a kitchen sink, a refrigerator, and cabinets.

Sources for finding a rental are: newspaper ads, Internet ads, and 복덕방 /부동산업자 (realtors who charge for their services).



## Tip of the Day

## **Waste Disposal**



Garbage disposal is a very important part of life in Seoul. Beginning with the waste disposal volume rate system put into operation in 1995, waste must be disposed of in standardized bags.

With the waste disposal volume rate system, all homes and businesses are required to pay according to the amount of waste they produce, and buy standard bags at sellers designated by the district mayor (neighborhood pharmacies and supermarkets). These bags must be tied before being put out.

Fluorescent lamps, broken glass, leftovers from housing repairs, and gardening wastes should be compacted, put into sturdy bags, and then put into the standard bags for disposal.

There are three types of standard bags. White bags are for domestic use only, such as single unit houses or apartment complexes. They have four different sizes of 5, 10, 20, and 50 liters. Light blue bags are for public use only, such as the public sanitation department. Their sizes are 50, 70, and 100 liters. Orange bags are for businesses, with sizes of 20, 50, and 100 liters.

## Tip of the Day

#### Waste Disposal



Separate collection of recyclable goods is an effective means of reducing waste. Recyclable goods are divided into five different groups: paper, glass, scrap iron, cans, and plastic. Apartment residents separate waste into these five groups and put them in different colored collection boxes. Individual residents bring their recyclable items to designated places twice every week. Classification and handling are as follows:

**Paper** - Newspapers, calendars, magazines, or notebooks in 30 cm bundles. Thoroughly clean milk cartons with water, unfold, and keep them tied together. **Glass** - Uncapped wine, soft drinks, and medicine bottles should be cleaned for recycling purposes.

**Scrap Iron** - Metal chairs, old tools, stainless steel, etc. should be collected for recycling purposes.

**Cans** – Beer cans, soft drinks, and powdered milk should be crushed before being recycled.

**Plastics** - Detergent and shampoo containers should be recycled after thorough cleaning with water.

Large volume wastes such as refrigerators and furniture, which are hard to dispose of, should be reported to the Sanitation Division of the district office (or ward offices) three days before disposal. Then, you will be given a written notice for the disposal fee you will need to pay at the bank. The fee is determined according to the size of the item.

TVs-3,000-5,000 won

Washing Machines- 3,000 won

Desks- 4,000-7,000 won Pianos- 15,000 won

# 1. Housing in Korea

There are many hotels and inns in Seoul, but for long stays, it is more economical to find boarding houses or rentals. They are available to rent through monthly payments or you may make a deposit. Nowadays, western style houses and apartments are becoming more available. Beds and sofas, along with traditional Korean-style bedding, are also provided.

## (1) To Rent a House

To find a residence in Seoul, you can consult real estate agencies, which are located throughout the city. However, they will charge you a commission fee for their services. It is most convenient to use real estate agencies in residential areas. Free informational newspapers from each of the districts are also available, which provide room sizes, rental rates, phone numbers of landlords, and other real estate information. Thus, it is possible to acquire a residence without the help of a real estate agent.

## Moving

It is convenient to use general movers (their telephone numbers are usually their office # + 2424), or packing movers who take care of the entire moving process from packing to the arrangement of furniture. Packing movers provide worldwide services, including shipment through their chain system. Electricity and water bills are priced according to the amount used by the tenant. Therefore, when moving in, you should always have the person who lived there before you pay their portion of the bills.

## **Water Supply**

Depending on the classification of the user, business or residential, water rates vary. The average amount of water used by a household in Seoul per month is 22t, which costs about 3,380 won. Any problems related to your water supply may be reported directly to the local waterworks office or by simply dialing 121 on your telephone.

#### **Electricity**

Electricity rates also vary for business and residential users. In Seoul, an average household consumes 263 KW per month, which costs about 25,000 won. Any problems related to the use of electricity should be reported by dialing 123 on your telephone. Presently, the voltage used is being transferred from 110V to 220V. Most of the newly built buildings now use 220V. Furthermore, one should report his/her "move in" to the new district office within 14 days.

# (2) Types of Residence

# **Temporary Lodging**

There are many hotels and inns in Seoul. You may choose one according to your needs. A **first class deluxe hotel** (five stars) is about 150,000 won per night (off season) and 190,000 won per night (in season). A **second class deluxe hotel** (five stars) runs from 120,000 won-170,000 won per night. A **first class hotel** (four stars) runs from 75,000 won-95,000 won per night, while a **second class hotel** (three stars) runs from 50,000 won-65, 000 won per night. A **third class hotel** (two stars) runs from 39,000 won-55, 000 won per night, and most inns charge around 30,000 won per night.

\*Prices above are subject to change.

# Officetels (오피스텔)

An officetel is a composite word made up of "office" and "hotel". It can be used as an office, as well as a residence. Foreign business people staying in Korea use officetels on a regular basis.

# Boarding Houses (하숙)

In order to stay in a boarding house in Korea, a small deposit must be made and rent must be paid monthly. Boarding houses provide tenants with a room and two meals a day, which some find to be quite convenient.

# System of Rent on a Deposit Basis (전세)

This is a system unique to Korea, where a large amount of money (usually around 50% of the total price of the house) must first be paid in full to the owner as a deposit. When the contract has expired, the full deposit is returned to the tenant. The period of contract can legally extend for over two years, but customarily the period is for one year. Before signing a contract, always be sure to confirm the settlement of mortgage by picking up a copy of the registration certificate from the Registry Office.

# Monthly Rent (월세)

After agreeing (and signing a contract) to pay a certain amount of rent over one or two years, one must make standard monthly payments until the contract is fulfilled.
